- Reduced Income expectations
 - Fall Book Fair due to going virtual this year
 - Fall Fundraiser income to \$12000
 - Box Top income reduced due to new Box Tops app program
- Expenses
 - Reduced Heritage Night
 - Rolling over balances from last year in spring events that didn't happen (beautification, Reading Ambassadors etc.)
 - \$5600 in direct teacher support
 - Added line item for emergency needs

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Fall Fundraiser Plan
